Paqui and Brian Kelly and the Kelly Cares Foundation donate \$250,000 to help build new home for Memorial Children's Hospital

Paqui and Brian Kelly 'Shine' for kids in our community

Paqui and Brian Kelly and the Kelly Cares Foundation have pledged \$250,000 to help fund the new home for Memorial Children's Hospital. This generous gift was donated as part of Shine: the Campaign for Memorial Children's Hospital, during which \$10 million will be raised to help expand and enhance pediatric health care services to children from throughout our region.

Plans for the new multi-story building, which will be constructed above the Memorial Leighton Trauma Center, include space for the General Pediatrics Unit, Pediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU), the Pediatric Hematology/Oncology Clinic, and Newborn Intensive Care Unit (NICU) Couplet Care and Single Family Rooms, along with playrooms and teen hideout spaces, Family Enrichment Centers, a roof garden, and a butterfly room for families grieving the loss of a child. The new facility will include all-private patient rooms, which are proven to enhance outcomes, reduce length of stay, improve safety and efficiency, strengthen communication and promote healing.

Nationally-renowned children's hospital architect Zimmer Gunsul Frasca (ZGF) led the design of the new home for Memorial Children's Hospital. In addition, patient families and associates from across Beacon Health System played an integral role in the design of the new space. Plans for groundbreaking will be announced shortly.

"There is nothing more important than protecting and nurturing families through their child's medical journey," says Kreg Gruber, President of Memorial Children's Hospital. "It is only through the philanthropic support of generous community members like Paqui and Brian and the Kelly Cares Foundation, that we will be able to ensure the best care for every family in our community when they need it most."

"The mission Memorial Children's Hospital coincides with the Kelly Cares Foundation's pillars of health, education and community," says Paqui Kelly. "This is why Brian and I support this Campaign."

Shine: the Campaign has raised nearly \$7 million toward its \$10 million goal and is led by Campaign Cabinet Co-Chairs Nancy and Peter Baranay, Kerie and Tracy Graham, Stephanie and Todd Schurz, and Julie and Jim Schwartz.
